

AUSTIN COUNTY JAIL MUSEUM



This grand example of Romanesque Revival architecture was the fourth jail for Austin County, built just a half block from the town square. You'll find many interesting artifacts and fun stories held within these weathered walls.

- 1896 Constructed
- 1901 Gallows used (first and only time)
- 1921 Living quarters first occupied by sheriff & family
- 1976 Awarded a Texas Historical Commission Medallion
 1980 Entered in National Register of Historic Places
- 1982 The last prisoner was removed
